We are very pleased to welcome you in the 4^{th} Network Meeting of the UV4Plants Association, taking place from the $3^{rd}-6t^h$ of July 2022 in Kraków, Poland. The training school for early stage researchers will be organized on $2^{nd}-3^{rd}$ of July 2022.

Training school:

The training school will be conducted at the **Faculty of Biochemistry**, **Biophysics and Biotechnology of Jagiellonian University**, **Gronostajowa 7**, **Kraków**, **Poland**. The school starts on Saturday 2nd of July at 9.00 a.m. and will finish at 5.30 p.m. On Sunday, the 3rd of July the school will be from 9.00 a.m. until 3.00 p.m. The entrance to the building will be through the main entrance marked with red arrows on Map 1.
