Dear Colleagues,

Here we give more information on the workshop and answer questions.

We have about 5 more places available and we look forward to receiving new registrations.

The workshop will include research talks (20 min with additional question time) and free discussions. There will be no poster session. Discussion topics include: identifying open, unanswered questions on the connection between UV and pigments; planning a joint common garden experiment; and technical issues and best practice in pigment measurements.

In addition to research talks, we encourage new and future PhD students to present their research plans with or without preliminary results (5-10 min).

How do I register? – A Registration form is attached to this email. Please email it to plantbiologypecs@gmail.com. Following registration, participants will receive instructions on how to pay registration fees. Deadline for payments: February 20, 2023.

I have already registered; how do I pay? – The workshop fee is €110.- for UV4Plants members, and €160.- for non-members. How do I submit an abstract? – An Abstract template is attached to this email. Please fill it in, rename the file using your name and send it to dlonra1991@gmail.com before March 10, 2023. Please send a .doc or .docx file (do not convert into .pdf).


A Book of Abstracts will be compiled and emailed to all registered participants as a .pdf booklet a few days before the meeting. There will be no printed versions distributed on site, and participants are encouraged to use the paper-free version. The Book of Abstracts will have an ISBN to make it citable in grant reports, theses, etc.

Abstract submission is mandatory for all participants who intend to give a research talk. Students who will present research plans are encouraged to submit a written abstract, but may opt not to if the research topic is to be treated as confidential. Students who wish to talk without submitting a written abstract should submit a title only.

I have registered, paid, and sent my abstract. Anything else to do? – Please book your accommodation, and arrange your travel. For practical information on location, venue, airport shuttle, and accommodation please consult the first circular. If you decided to stay at the hotel where the workshop will take place, you have already received an email on how to contact the hotel and book your room.
